Mark Making and Drawing (this will be taught in Autumn 1 and the children will have lots of opportunities throughout the year to mark make and draw): Exploring mark making and line, working and experimenting with different materials through observational drawing and collaborative pieces. Using a variety of drawings tools – make dark, medium and light tones using different grades of pencil and chalk. Observing and drawing landscapes from different viewpoints. Thinking about foreground and background, scale and proportion and patterns, exploring different lines perspective and composition. Beginning to fill their paper Drawing a simple picture from imagination and memory Beginning to draw what they can see rather than what they think they can see.
